Annuario Parochialis / **A Parish Yearbook** has recently been retrieved from old parochial house. Some of the entries to the parish's official yearbook will be included over the following weeks:

- Rev William O'Neill was appointed Parish Priest of the Parish of Killavullen on 7th April 1951 by the Most Rev. Dr James Roche DD, Bishop of Cloyne
- Ballygown National School. This school was build in 1959. The school was opened by the Rev. William O'Neill PP on June 22, 1959. Mass was celebrated and the school blessed on that morning. The total cost of the school was £5,000.
- January 22, 1969: Fr D. O'Driscoll CC was transferred to Newmarket. He was replaced by Fr P. Hegarty.
- 1969: The Curate's House in Monanimy was sold to Mr Patrick Murphy, retired bank manager. A Roh-Fab building was erected at Ballymacmoy on a site granted to the parish by the Hennessy family.
