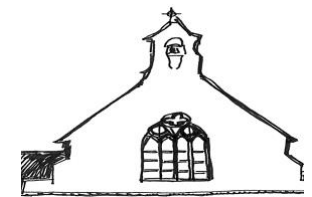

Twenty Fourth Sunday: *Jesus, the Messiah/ Christ, the chosen one of God*

First Reading: Writing in the Seventh Century BC, the Prophet Isaiah believed that a new covenant with God would be established through a new type of messiah, not a powerful ruler, but a ‘suffering servant’.

Psalms 114 – The Lord upholds those who are distressed

Second Reading: Our faith is expressed through our good deeds.

Gospel: Half ways into the Gospel of Mark we reach its turning point: Jesus’ miracles have left a deep impression on his disciples and they have come to acclaim him as the Messiah. But he rebukes Simon Peter who thinks that he should be powerful Messiah, like King David.
