Thirtieth Sunday The Lord rescues us from our distress

1st Reading: The Book of Jeremiah was written during the exile of Israel into Babylon. He was a prophet who "comforted my people" with the message that God would save those who remained faithful. **Responsorial Psalm**: The Lord has delivered us. We give thanks. 2nd Reading: The Son of God was able to "sympathise" fully with the human experience; he brings us into God's presence.

Gospel: Bartimaeus, a blind beggar sitting on the side of the road outside Jericho was able to see with the eves of faith and recognise Jesus as the "Son of David", the expected Messiah. Once healed, he cast off the robe of his old identity and followed Jesus. From what bondage might we be delivered, and so become a free and faithful follower of the Lord?
